BIOGRAPHY

Catherine Morgan graduated from the Kansas City Art Institute in 1998, having earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree with an emphasis in Photography. Upon graduating and moving to Houston, Morgan and her family conceived the idea for a residential artists facility that would allow her to thrive within a creative community alongside fellow craft artists. From this vision, the Houston Center of Contemporary Craft (HCCC) was founded in 2001.

While Morgan's early years were defined by health challenges that many believed might limit her, she met those obstacles with resilience and quiet determination. This outlook allowed her to transform hardship into a distinct creative perspective, shaped by both her acute intelligence and the steadfast support of her family. Frequent artistic encounters continue to inspire her, and art has long been a source of personal expression and healing for Catherine Morgan.

Morgan currently works from her studio and photo lab as a multidisciplinary artist whose practice spans photography, painting and collage, glass, weaving, clay, and jewelry. Her photography work is included in numerous private collections; she has also exhibited her jewelry work in Houston, through participation in Goldesberry Gallery's Jewelry Invitational. This summer, Morgan will attend a summer workshop in printing at the Haystack Mountain School of Crafts in Maine.
